APPLICATION FOR ELECTRIC LINE EXTENSION

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "Applicant") hereby agrees to purchase electric energy from BARC Electric Cooperative, (hereinafter called the "Cooperative") upon the following terms and conditions:

1. The Applicant will pay the Cooperative a membership fee, service charge, and/or deposit as required.
2. The Applicant will cause his premises to be wired in accordance with wiring specifications approved by the Cooperative.
3. The Applicant will comply with and be bound by the provisions of the Certificate of Incorporation and bylaws of the Cooperative, and such rules and regulations as may from time to time be adopted by the Cooperative.
4. The Applicant, by paying a membership fee and becoming a member, assumes no personal liability or responsibility for any debts or liabilities of the Cooperative, and it is expressly understood that under the law no private property can be taken for any such Cooperative debts or liabilities. You are informed a part of your future electric bills will be used by the Cooperative for subscription to the magazine "Rural Living".
5. The Applicant will, when electric energy becomes available, purchase from the Cooperative electric energy used on the premises described below and will pay therefore at rates to be determined from time to time by the Board of Directors, in accordance with the bylaws of the Cooperative, provided, however, that the Cooperative may limit the amount of electric energy to be furnished for industrial uses, if the Applicant does not accept energy for a period of twelve months from the date it becomes available, the Applicant will pay for that portion of the twelve months period energy is not accepted, based upon the minimum charge.
6. The Applicant will receive from the U. S. Postal Services a complete three-line address for billing and communication purposes with the Cooperative.
7. Applicant agrees to complete either an Overhead Easement Agreement or an Underground Easement Agreement or both under this particular Application for Electric Line Extension, and further agrees to complete either an Overhead Easement Agreement or an Underground Easement Agreement or both for all land or property owned by Applicant on which facilities of Co-op now exist.
8. Owner shall provide means for Co-op to install a Co-op padlock, along with Owner's lock, on any lockable gate or bar that now exists or may exist in the future through which Co-op must pass to repair or maintain Co-op facilities or right-of-way.
